M, N, O, in the second column, and those beginning P, Q, R, S, T, U, V, W, X, Y, Z in the third column, Having found the family name page make your search in proper column for given name, if known. Additional Given Name columns can be added when desired.

The General Index can be ruled in any manner required, and is adapted for the indexing of all kinds of records, and for any number of names from 10,000 up to 1,000,000 or more.
